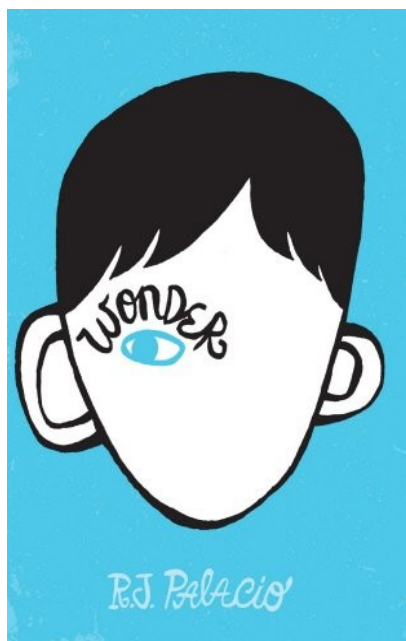
Whole Class Reading
